Basic Things You Need to Know

First Club Meetings: Mini 4-Hers are welcome at any of our classes; no separate meeting dates/times. All obedience/showmanship meetings are on Tuesday evenings.

- March 9 (6:00) without dogs at Howard County Government Building
- March 16 (6:00 for 1A & 1B/7:00 for 2A, 2B & all other classes) with dogs at Greentown Fairgrounds in Metal Building (must have vaccination records!)

Club Website: www.puppypushers.com - training class schedules, along with other reference information/links, will be posted there. If Eastern school is cancelled due to weather, our dog club class at Greentown is cancelled also.

What to bring for training classes: Dog, properly fitted collar with no tags, leash, treats your dog likes, water

Showmanship (optional): Requires a special show lead. The leaders will assist you in determining which kind is best for your breed of dog and can order one for you if you don't already have one.

Agility (optional): Must pass a test to compete. See one of the leaders for details.

Fund Raising: Our club will have fund raising opportunities throughout the year.

Pre-registration form: Must be filled out and returned to either a leader or the extension office by June 1. This will help us plan our show day times.

Pre-Show Set Up: Friday, June 25 – time TBD - we need as many helpers as possible!!!!

Fair Week: Our club will need volunteers to work a shift watching the 4-H buildings during our scheduled time. We will also perform demonstrations a few nights during the fair which is a good distraction practice for state fair!

Community Service Projects: Our club participates in the Humane Society's Barktober Event in October and also donates wish-list items to the Humane Society

Fun Matches: Several counties offer fun matches throughout the summer. This is a good practice show before our county show or even state fair. See the leaders for opportunities.

State Fair: Any club member may register and show at state fair regardless of placing at county fair. See leaders for details.
